Award Categories

Award recipients are based upon submitted community nominations.

Citizen of the Year: The Citizen of the Year is an individual who has had a major positive impact and involvement in the community, business, service or government through years of service in a leadership role. This individual is concerned about community betterment and has volunteered their time from personal and professional life to contribute toward the good of the community.

Junior Citizen of the Year: The Junior Citizen of the Year is an individual who must be in grades 7-12 in Mills County who has a positive impact and involvement in the community and school, and demonstrates strong leadership within their peer group. (must include the student's activities and community involvement. May NOT be nominated by a family member.)

Educator of the Year: An individual who has inspired and motivated children. Has had a long-term positive influence, making a difference in the lives of their students.

Customer Service of the Year: This award goes to a business or individual who provides excellent service to customers through friendliness, good service, helpfulness, and a pleasant, welcoming environment.

Club/Organization of the Year: A non-profit club, church, or organization that has exhibited concern for community betterment and/or has volunteered time to contribute toward the good of the community.

Community Connection Award: The Community Connection Award goes to a chamber member that continuously contributes to the betterment of our community through his or her business organization as well as on a personal level.

Recognition will be given to all award nominees and new Chamber Member businesses, individuals, clubs and organizations.
